

Wood Maintenance & Care

Proper care and maintenance of our tabletops will ensure years of satisfactory use. Only the finest materials available have been used in construction of this top. As with any fine wood furniture, reasonable care must be exercised in daily cleaning.

Please use only a slightly water-dampened soft, non-abrasive cloth with a weak dishwashing liquid. The surface should then be wiped down with a soft dry cloth to remove any excess moisture.

For challenging spots or dried on stains, make a paste with water and baking soda, and rub in with small soft brush or a sponge. Rinse with clear water.

DO NOT USE POWDERED CLEANERS, AMMONIA, DEGREASER, SILICONE, BLEACH OR ABRASIVE CLEANERS.

Spills of <u>any</u> liquid must be wiped dry immediately. A non-wax build-up polish may be used for added protection. Scratches may be repaired by using a colored wax repair stick. Care for this product as you would care for your fine household furniture.
